


THE PROBLEM Resource Scarcity → High Costs → Huge Impact on Environment

- Goal to zero out U.S. electricity sector carbon emissions by 2035










Growth in Clean Energy ETFs (US)



Global Clean Energy, vs Traditional Global Energy – Growth of 10,000 over 10 years






